

# FINANCIAL CAPABILITY CHECKLIST AND OUTLINE OF EXPENSES

Bond University is required to ensure that all international students entering Australia to study programs at Bond University meet the Department of Immigration and Citizenship's Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) and Genuine Student (GS) requirements. The University requires all students to complete this form, to demonstrate that you are aware of your financial commitment for studying and living in Australia, and that you have the necessary resources to study and live in Australia for the duration of your degree.

Additionally, Bond University requires you to make a declaration regarding the source of those funds to pay for tuition and living expenses for the duration of your studies in Australia.

**This form must be completed and submitted at the time of acceptance of the offer to Bond University before an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE) can be issued.**

Students cannot rely on gaining employment to fund their tuition or living expenses while in Australia. All students must have the required AUD \$18,610 per annum for living expenses (as stipulated by the Australian Government) to support themselves while studying their chosen degree. These amounts are the minimum required for establishing a student's financial capability. They do not necessarily represent the cost of living in Australia.
