- Diploma of Multimedia

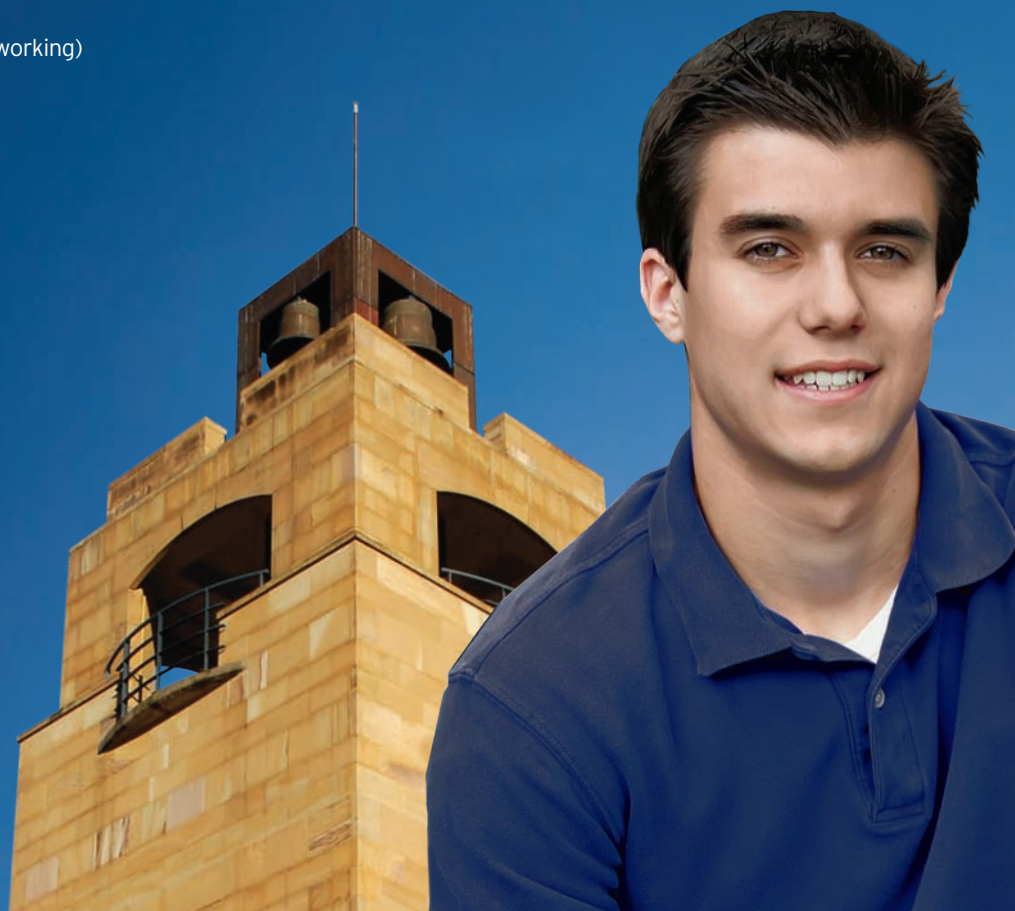
SCHOLARSHIPS
