Bond University has a distinguished reputation as Australia's first private, not-for-profit university, offering a personalised academic environment that enables graduates to exceed the outer limits of their potential.



Bond's trimester structure provides convenient start dates for students with semesters starting in January, May and September. - Students can apply for credit for other HOSTEC courses and will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
- The time to completion may vary depending on how many subjects are exempt.

*The program durations listed above are based on students undertaking a full-time study load, at 40 credit points per semester. Student Visa holders must enrol in a minimum study load of 30 credit points per semester, but can request approval from the Faculty to enrol in 40 credit points per semester.
