Abstract (Summary)
At first, the men who found them thought the dark object in the water was a farmer's scarecrow, but on closer inspection they realized it was two waterlogged, decomposing corpses tied together. In fact, Dr. Keith Simpson, an equally renowned British pathologist, said in a foreword to Smith's book, No expert in the art of medical detection has ever enjoyed the respect and affection of his fellow pathologists as Sydney Smith did, and few have extracted so much run from a macabre profession.
